For more than 30 years, HOPE is organising at the end of the annual Exchange Programme an evaluation meeting renamed more recently Agora. Participants spend four weeks in a European country to learn about how similar healthcare issues are tackled differently. During the Agora event HOPE Exchange participants and some of their hosts are gathering in one place to cover a single topic.

The HOPE Agora 2022 will take place from 3 to 5 June 2022 in Brussels focusing on: "Using Evidence in Healthcare Management". It directly follows and builds on the HOPE Agora 2019 which topic was "Evidence-Informed Decision-making in Healthcare Management". This approach means that policy-making and managerial decisions should be based on best available evidence and not on beliefs and long-established practices. In increasingly complex health systems, the ability to use all types of available evidence to improve decision-making in healthcare is crucial to ensure that citizens are offered the best care possible.

The conference will host all the HOPE Exchange Programme participants, some of their hosts as well as experts and HOPE members representatives.
