The team and management uses a board where all of the staff at hand are presented with their level of knowledge in terms of Covid-19 and speciality:





Anagement of Hospital Beds

Solutions in France







Adult ER Situation at University Hospital of Poitiers in 2013:

- Patients staying overnight on stretchers
- Patients not attended by a proper specialist
- ER doctors isolated from other specialists



Goal:

 \rightarrow to control the daily random entries and try to determine the required overall bed capacity in hospital care units to accommodate these patients.

- Scheduled activity (financing according to the occupancy rate)
- *Emergency activity* (dedicated beds)



No significant fluctuations were found:

- By rate of hospitalizations (40% of ER patients were hospitalized)
- By month and week days
- By speciality (20% surgery; 80% medicine)

But...

They discovered a **strong variation** of the hospitalization rate each day



How to determine the number of beds necessary to be reserved for ER impatients?

→ cross the needs of ER with percentage of hospital occupation using **specialized software**

Conclusion (1)

- Decision-making strategies during COVID-19 wrt. medical materials shortage:
 - Common knowledge
 - Consulting supervisors and colleagues
 - No significant difference in use of scientific literature across time
 → Poor use of evidence?

• Shortage of personnel is more important within the last month than during the peak Covid-19 outbreak

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- Main factor: difficulty with recruitment
- Management of beds and medical materials is steadily returning to pre-Covid-19 levels within past month
 - However current shortage of personnel is the main factor affecting management of beds

Conclusion (2)



- COVID-19 a major strain on hospitals and personnel
- Initial survey of French hospitals provided very valuable information
- Three examples of successful evidence management related to our three survey themes

Future Work



- Survey of greater sample size
 - Analysing results across different levels of management
 - Acquiring patient perspective
- Focus on *why* use *scientific literature* was not increased to aid in decision-making during pandemic
 - Motivation: *let's increase its use!*
- Explore strategies for recruitment of new medical personnel
- New questions relating to continually evolving pandemic situation
