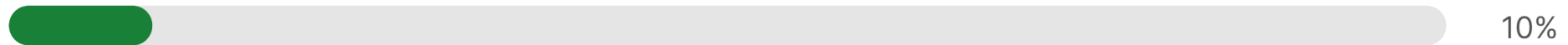

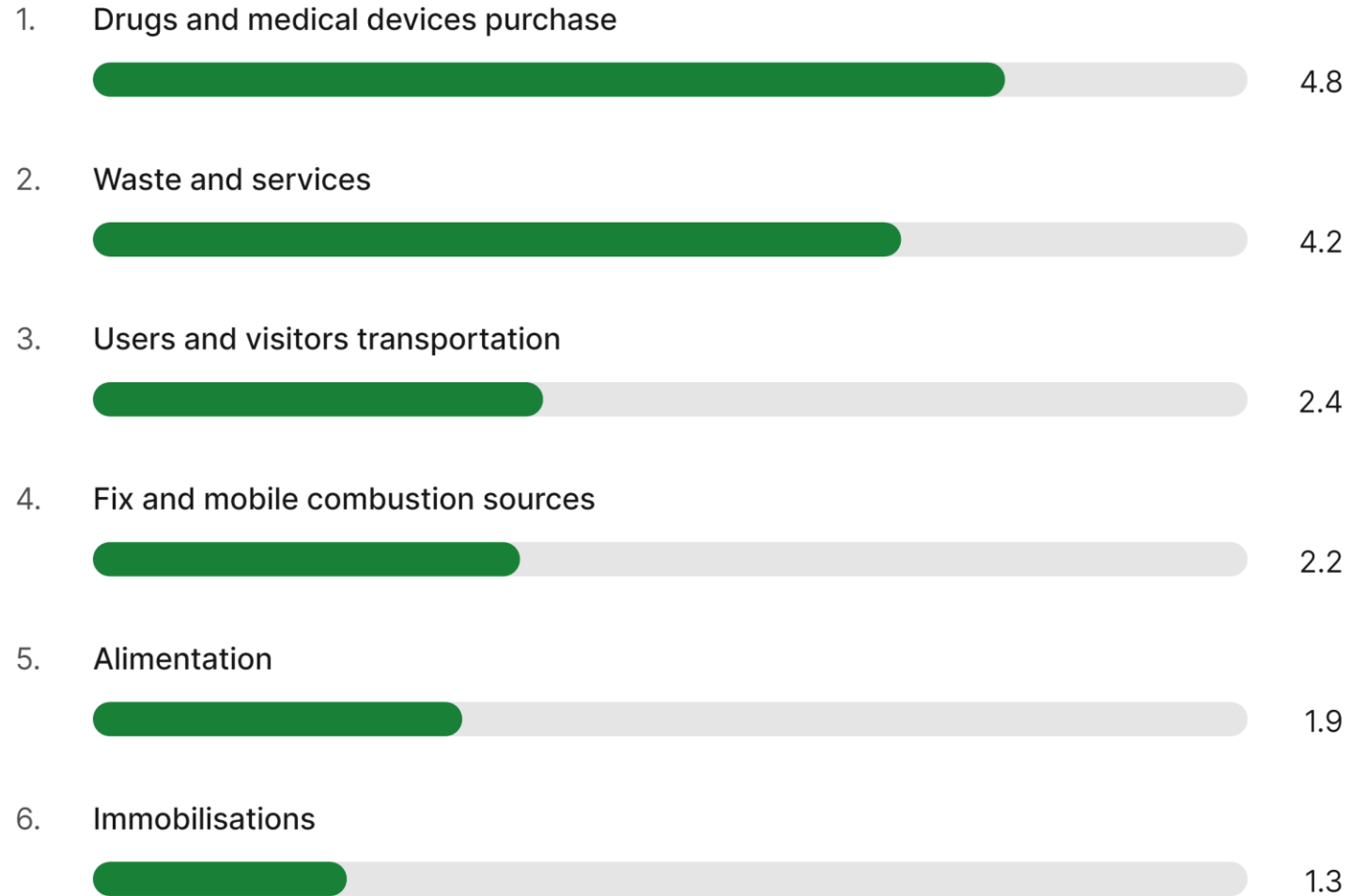
- ▶ 5% on average, making the sector comparable in importance to the food sector

# What is World Café?

---

- Simple, effective, and flexible format for hosting **group dialogue**
- Aims at harnessing **collective wisdom** and NOT at reaching a resolution
- Fosters conversation between small group to **share** their perspectives and ideas on a topic or question, before **moving on** to explore a different area with a different group of people.

**TABLE 1:** PANDEMIC FEELINGS: given 4 phases of the pandemic, we will play a game to remember and empathize with others on feelings and memories of the pandemic period, through positioning of photos and voting mechanism (boardgame, with printed photos and posters)

**TABLE 2:** MY LOCKDOWN ESCAPE: by using a hybrid setup (digital + physical) we will play an Escape Room game in the context of the pandemic, to revive our lockdown experiences and contribute some information about our perception and memories of those days, ... and thus escape our lockdown room.
